Resurrection Catholic School Financial Aid Opportunities 2024-2025 School Year

Resurrection Catholic School is committed to helping families afford their children a Catholic education. There are many opportunities for financial assistance for students at RCS. The secret is to stay on top of communication from the school and apply early. Here are some of our most popular options for financial aid:

State Funded Scholarships:

Beginning in Fall of 2023, ALL families in the state of Florida are eligible for financial aid through the state, regardless of academic or financial need. This Scholarship is open through the School Choice Office in the State of Florida. During the 2023-2024 school year, students in kindergarten through grade 3 received \$7,933 while students in grades 4-8 received \$7,306. 95% of our students received this scholarship and no families were denied. Once the application window opens for the 24-25 school year, parents will receive communication from the school. Please be sure to apply early, check your emails and communicate with our school office once you receive the award.

Facts Grant and Aid:

Resurrection Catholic School has limited scholarship dollars available to students. Parents must apply through FACTS Grant and Aid (https://online.factsmgt.com/aid). When the scholarship committee meets in early summer, they will only consider those families that have submitted Award Id #s for the State Funded Scholarship (see above). *Parents seeking financial aid must first apply for the State Funded Scholarship before being considered for additional school based dollars. In early summer, applicants for FACTS Grant and Aid can anticipate a letter from the Scholarship committee, and the award will be applied to the amount due on FACTS Tuition Management.

St. Joseph Education Foundation:

Financial assistance may be available for St. Joseph Catholic Church members through the St. Joseph Education Foundation. Please contact St. Joseph Catholic Church for information.

- *Families receiving tuition assistance who choose to withdraw mid-year will forfeit the refund of paid tuition.
