Uniform Policy

2024-2025

School Year

All students must be in uniform every day. If there is a time when the prescribed uniform cannot for some legitimate reason be worn, a note from the parent/guardian must be written to the teachers. Students who are out of uniform without an excuse are sent to the office and will face consequences as indicated below. The administration reserves the right to judge the appropriateness of the student's appearance. The Resurrection Catholic School Uniform Policy has been approved by the School Board, School Administration, and Pastor.

BOYS KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 8TH GRADE

Hair:

Only natural hair color. Hair must be cut above the eyebrows and above the collar. Shaved heads or designs in the hair are not permitted. No facial hair is allowed.

Shirt:

Red, white, or navy school logo shirt with long or short sleeves. (Students may choose between a knit or dri fit navy shirt.) Shirts must be tucked into pants or shorts. If students choose to wear undershirts, only solid white shirts are permitted. Only the top button is allowed to be unbuttoned. * Red knit school shirt with the school logo is being phased out and will be permitted only during the 2024-2025 school year.

Shorts:

Boys may wear gray uniform shorts or gray uniform trousers purchased from Risse Brothers, fitted appropriately at the waist. Boys MUST have one pair of gray uniform trousers for Mass days and cold weather.

Belt:

Black or brown solid plain belt is required on shorts or pants for boys in grades 2-8.

Socks:

Students must wear socks with shoes. Socks must be a solid dark or solid white with no markings. Socks should not extend higher than the calf.

Shoes:

Athletic shoes must be solid black or solid white and may have one accent color. Laces must match the color of the shoe, either solid black or white.

Outerwear:

Students in Kindergarten through Grade 5 may wear Resurrection logo uniform sweatshirts during the cold months in the classrooms. Additionally, the Resurrection logo blue zip up jacket or gray sweatshirt sold by Risse Brothers are acceptable for students in kindergarten through grade 8. Teachers and administration reserve the right to tell students that they are not permitted to wear sweatshirts or jackets when weather doesn't necessitate outerwear.

* The Resurrection Catholic School hoodie and the red RCS sweatshirt are being phased out and will be permitted only during the 2024-2025 school year.

Jewelry — Boys may wear one chain/necklace. Boys may not wear earrings, ear gauges, or spacers. One bracelet/watch may be worn on each wrist.

NO MAKE-UP, NO TATTOOS, OR TENNIS SHOES WITH WHEELS.

GIRLS KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 8TH GRADE

Hair:

Only natural hair color. No extremes in length or style, no shaved heads, or designs or two tone hair. Hats, bandanas, headbands with ears, hair tinsel, or sunglasses are not acceptable.

Shirt:

Short sleeve white Peter Pan blouse, **or** red, white, or navy school RCS logo shirt with long or short sleeves. (Students may choose between a knit or dri fit navy shirt.) Shirts must be tucked in. If students choose to wear undershirts, only solid white are permitted. Only the top button of all shirts may be unbuttoned. *Red knit school shirt with the school logo is being phased out and will be permitted only during the 2024-2025 school year.

Jumper/Skirts:

Plaid jumper with drop waist **or** knit drop waist logo dress (in either red or navy) may be worn by girls in kindergarten through Grade 3 on non-Mass days. *Red knit drop waist logo dress with the school logo is being phased out and will be permitted only during the 2024-2025 school year.

Plaid skirt, gray uniform shorts, or gray slacks may be worn by girls in Grades kindergarten through grade 8 on non-Mass days.

Slacks may not be worn under the jumper/skirt.

Skirts, jumpers, dresses, and shorts may not be shorter than 2 inches above the bend of the knee.

Belt:

Black or brown solid plain belt is required on shorts or pants for girls in grades 2-8.

Socks:

Socks are required. Girls may wear solid white or solid black socks with no markings. Socks cannot extend above the knee.

Tights:

Solid gray, white, black or navy tights with no markings. Tights extend from the hips to the tip of the toe. Tights may be worn under a skirt, dress, or jumper on cold days.

Shoes:

Athletic shoes must be solid black or solid white and may have one accent color. Laces must match the color of the shoe, either solid black or white.

Outerwear:

Students may wear Resurrection logo uniform sweatshirts during the cold months in the classrooms. The Resurrection logo blue zip up jacket or gray sweatshirt sold by Risse Brothers are acceptable for students in kindergarten through grade 8. Teachers and administration reserve the right to tell students that they are not

permitted to wear sweatshirts or jackets when weather doesn't necessitate outerwear.

* The Resurrection Catholic School hoodie and the red RCS sweatshirt are being phased out and will be permitted only during the 2024-2025 school year.

Jewelry — Earrings—One earring per lobe, which cannot be larger than a dime. For safety reasons, hoop or dangle earrings may not be worn. One necklace and one bracelet (per wrist) may be worn.

NO MAKE-UP, NO ARTIFICIAL NAILS, NO TATTOOS, OR TENNIS SHOES WITH WHEELS.
If nail polish is worn, all fingernails must be the same color and nails short. Artificial nails or press on nails are not allowed.

MASS UNIFORM

BOYS KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 3

Shirt — Blue/white striped or light blue oxford short sleeve shirt with RCS logo; must be tucked in.

Pants — Gray uniform trousers (Long pants).

Belt — Black or Brown Belt solid, plain for grades 3-8

Shoes – Solid black or solid white tennis shoes with matching black or white laces. Laces must match the color of the shoe.

BOYS GRADE 4 THROUGH GRADE 8

Shirt — Blue/white striped or light blue oxford short sleeve shirt with RCS logo; must be tucked in.

Pants — Gray uniform trousers (Long pants).

Tie- Navy (Risse Brothers) should extend the length of the torso. Grades 4 through 8

Belt — Black or Brown Belt solid, plain for grades 3-8

Shoes – Solid black or solid white tennis shoes with matching black or white laces. Laces must match the color of the shoe.

GIRLS KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 3

Shirt—Short sleeve white Peter Pan blouse or white knit RCS school logo polo with long or short sleeves

Pants — Plaid jumper with drop waist

Tights — **Solid gray, white, black or navy tights with no markings.** Tights extend from the hips to the tip of the toe. Tights may be worn under the jumper on cold days.

Shoes — Solid black or solid white tennis shoes with matching black or white laces. Laces must match the color of the shoe.

GIRLS GRADE 4 THROUGH GRADE 8

Shirt—Navy knit blouse with long or short sleeves or white knit blouse with long or short sleeves

Pants —Plaid skirt (Risse Brothers). Skirts should not be shorter than 2” above the bend of the knee (back of leg).

Shoes — Solid black or solid white tennis shoes with matching black or white laces. Laces must match the color of the shoe.

PE UNIFORM — BOYS AND GIRLS (WORN ALL DAY ON PE DAYS EXCEPT MASS DAYS)

All students have the same PE uniform.

Shorts – Navy gym shorts with Big R Logo purchased from Risse Brothers

Shirt – PE Shirts purchased from Risse Brothers. *PE shirts sold by the RCS Athletic Department are being phased out and will be permitted only during the 2024-2025 school year.

Sweatpants – Gray sweatpants purchased from Risse Brothers are permitted on cold weather days when the student has PE.

DRESS DOWN DAY DRESS CODE

Dress Down Days are announced during the course of the school year. Some are free dress days, while others serve as a fundraiser and students may be charged a small fee if they dress down. A student may also dress down on his/her birthday OR on the day before or the next school day if their birthday falls on a Mass day or non-school day or weekend.

Guidelines for Dress Down Days and School-Sanctioned Events for all students are as follows:

The rules for Dress Down Days (excluding shoes) apply to school events that are approved by the administration. Such events include but are not limited to award ceremonies, dinners, dances, socials, pep rallies and field trips.

- Jeans, slacks, Bermuda shorts, Capri pants and skirts of appropriate length and condition (may not have holes, rips, or frayed). Shorts or skirts may not be shorter than 3” above the knee.
- No strapless, spaghetti straps, backless halters, bare midriffs, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, shirts with shoulders cut out, sundresses, or exposed underwear.
- All shoes must be closed toe shoes and socks must be worn. No sandals, open toed, or backless shoes including Crocs are allowed. Boots are never permitted.
- No hats, caps, visors, bandanas, fashion scarves, or sunglasses are permitted during the school day.
- If a student’s scheduled PE class falls on a free dress day, the student must wear/bring clothes conducive to PE including athletic shoes for class. Non-compliance will incur a referral.

LOST AND FOUND

Label all student clothing and belongings. Unclaimed clothing and supplies found in the school are brought to the Lost and Found. We have hundreds of dollars’ worth of articles lost annually. Periodically, unclaimed items are washed and put into the Used Uniform store.
