Resurrection Catholic School Uniform Policy 2023-2024 School Year

All students must be in uniform every day. If there is a time when the prescribed uniform cannot for some legitimate reason be worn, a note from the parent/guardian must be written to the teachers. Students who are out of uniform without an excuse are sent to the office and will face consequences as indicated below. The administration reserves the right to judge the appropriateness of the student's appearance. The RCS Uniform Policy has been approved by the School Board, School Administration and Pastor.

Our uniform vendor is Risse Brothers

BOYS KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 8TH GRADE

Hair:

Only natural hair color. Hair must be cut above the eyebrows and above the collar. Shaved heads or designs in the hair are not permitted. No facial hair is allowed.

Shirt:

Boys in grades in kindergarten through grade 5 should wear Red knit school logo shirt with long or short sleeves **or** white knit school logo shirt with long or short sleeves must be tucked in.

Boys in grades 6-8 should wear Navy knit shirt with long or short sleeves or white knit school logo shirt with long or short sleeves must be tucked in.

If students choose to wear undershirts, only solid white shirts are permitted. Only the top button is allowed to be unbuttoned

Shorts:

Boys may wear gray uniform shorts or gray uniform trousers purchased from Risse Brothers.

Belt:

Students in grades 2-8 must wear a belt with uniform shorts or trousers.

Socks:

Students must wear socks with shoes. Socks must be a solid dark or solid white. Small, appropriate logos are acceptable. Bright color socks or socks that draw attention are NOT part of the uniform.

Shoes:

Athletic shoes should be predominantly black or predominantly white. Shoes may have one accent color. Laces should match the predominant color of the shoes (either black or white). Shoes that have graphics, pictures, or writing on them are not allowed. Additionally, shoes that are patterned (checkerboard, striped, etc) are not allowed.

Outerwear:

Students in Kindergarten through Grade 5 may wear Resurrection logo uniform sweatshirts during the cold months in the classrooms. Additionally, the Resurrection logo blue zip up jacket is acceptable. Teachers and administration reserve the right to tell students that they are not permitted to wear sweatshirts or jackets when

weather doesn't necessitate outerwear. * The Resurrection Catholic School hoodie is being phased out and will be permitted only during the 2024-2025 school year.

Jewelry — Boys may wear one chain/necklace. Boys may not wear earrings, ear gauges, or spacers. One bracelet/watch may be worn on each wrist.

NO MAKE-UP, NO TATTOOS, OR TENNIS SHOES WITH WHEELS.

GIRLS KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 8TH GRADE

Hair:

Only natural hair color. No extremes in length or style, no shaved heads, or designs or two tone hair. Hats, bandanas, headbands with ears, hair tinsel, or sunglasses are not acceptable.

Shirt:

Girls in kindergarten through Grade 5 should wear Short sleeve white Peter Pan blouse, red knit school RCS logo shirt with long or short sleeves, or white knit school RCS logo shirt with long or short sleeves must be tucked in.

Girls in grades 6-8 should wear a navy knit school logo shirt with long or short sleeves or white knit school logo shirt with short or long sleeves. Shirts must be tucked in.

Only the top button of all shirts may be unbuttoned.

Jumper/Skirts:

Plaid jumper with drop waist, red knit drop waist logo dress, culottes, gray shorts or slacks may be worn by girls in kindergarten through grade 5 on non-Mass days.

Plaid skirt, gray uniform shorts, or gray slacks may be worn by girls in Grades 6-8 on non-Mass days.

Slacks may not be worn under the jumper/skirt.

Skirts and shorts may not be shorter than 2 inches above the bend of the knee.

Belt:

Belts are required for all students in grades 2-8 when belt loops are present.

Socks:

Socks are required. Girls may wear solid white/red/navy/gray socks. Small, appropriate logos are acceptable. Bright color socks or socks that draw attention are NOT part of the uniform.

Tights/Leggings:

Gray, white, or black tights or leggings are acceptable under jumper or skirts on cold weather days.

Shoes:

Athletic shoes should be predominantly black or predominantly white. Shoes may have one accent color. Laces should match the predominant color of the shoes (either black or white). Shoes that have graphics,

pictures, or writing on them are not allowed. Additionally, shoes that are patterned (checkerboard, striped, etc) are not allowed.

Outerwear:

Students in Kindergarten through Grade 5 may wear Resurrection logo uniform sweatshirts during the cold months in the classrooms. Additionally, the Resurrection logo blue zip up jacket is acceptable. Teachers and administration reserve the right to tell students that they are not permitted to wear sweatshirts or jackets when weather doesn't necessitate outerwear.

* The Resurrection Catholic School hoodie is being phased out and will be permitted only during the 2024-2025 school year.

Jewelry — *Earrings*—For safety, girls may wear post earrings or small hoops that hug the bottom of the ear. One earring per ear. No ear gauges. One necklace and one bracelet (per wrist) may be worn. Nose rings are not permitted.

NO MAKE-UP, NO ARTIFICIAL NAILS, NO TATTOOS, OR TENNIS SHOES WITH WHEELS. If nail polish is worn, all fingernails must be the same color and nails short. Artificial nails or press on nails are not allowed.

MASS UNIFORM

BOYS

Shirt — Blue/white striped oxford short sleeve shirt with RCS logo (Kindergarten – Grade 5); must be tucked in. Light Blue oxford short sleeve shirt with RCS logo (Grades 6-8); must be tucked in.

Pants — Gray uniform trousers (Long pants) for Kindergarten through Grade 8.

Belt — Belt is required for all boys Grade 2-8

Shoes – Should be mostly black or mostly white (dress or athletic shoes are permitted)

GIRLS

Shirt—Short sleeve white Peter Pan blouse or white knit RCS school logo polo with long or short sleeves (kindergarten – Gr 5)

Navy knit blouse with long or short sleeves or white knit blouse with long or short sleeves (Grades 6-8)

Pants — Plaid jumper with drop waist (Kindergarten through Grade 5)

Plaid skirt (Grades 6-8). Skirts should not be shorter than 2" above the bend of the knee (back of leg).

Shoes — Shoes should be mostly black or mostly white (dress or athletic shoes permitted).

PE UNIFORM — BOYS AND GIRLS (WORN ALL DAY ON PE DAYS EXCEPT MASS DAYS)

All students have the same PE uniform.

Shorts – Navy gym shorts with Big R Logo purchased from Risse Brothers (Kindergarten – Grade 8)

Shirt – PE Shirts are sold by the athletic department.

Sweatpants – On cold days, students may wear gray sweatpants and an RCS sweatshirt or hoodie to PE.

DRESS DOWN DAY DRESS CODE

Dress Down Days are announced during the course of the school year. Some are free dress days, while others serve as a fundraiser and students may be charged a small fee if they dress down. A student may also dress down on his/her birthday OR on the day before or the next school day if their birthday falls on a Mass day or non-school day or weekend.

Guidelines for Dress Down Days and School-Sanctioned Events for all students are as follows:

The rules for Dress Down Days (excluding shoes) apply to school events that are approved by the administration. Such events include but are not limited to award ceremonies, dinners, dances, socials, pep rallies and field trips.

- Jeans, slacks, Bermuda shorts, Capri pants and skirts of appropriate length and condition (may not have holes, rips, or frayed). Shorts or shirts may not be shorter than 3" above the knee.
- No strapless, spaghetti straps, backless halters, bare midriffs, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, shirts with shoulders cut out, sundresses, or exposed underwear.
- All shoes must be closed toe shoes and socks must be worn. No sandals, open toed or backless shoes including Crocs are allowed. Boots are never permitted.
- No hats, caps, visors, bandanas, fashion scarves, or sunglasses are permitted during the school day.
- If a student's scheduled PE class falls on a free dress day, the student must wear/bring clothes conducive to PE including athletic shoes for class. Non-compliance will incur a referral.

LOST AND FOUND

Label all student clothing and belongings. Unclaimed clothing and supplies found in the school are brought to the Lost and Found. We have hundreds of dollars' worth of articles lost annually. Periodically, unclaimed items are washed and put into the Used Uniform store.
